Over the past several years, there has been much discussion about training the protection phase in the sport of Schutzhund. The use of "training tables" was recently discussed in the Schutzhund USA magazine in a positive manner; however, the article did not provide a step by step training approach, to teach the skills necessary for effective behavior modification. Unfortunately, over the years, many have misused tables in a way that the inventor never intended. These well intentioned, but uneducated people, have created controversy surrounding the use of tables in the protection phase of Schutzhund.

Gene England invented the programs that utilized table training to control the dogs' environment, thus enabling a helper to present clear boundaries to teach your dog the skills it needs to excel in the protection work phase.

This seminar is an opportunity for training helpers to learn how to use the tables as Gene intended them to be used. Helpers will have the opportunity to learn from Gene how to limit a dog's options, so that the dog chooses the correct response. Used properly, tables allow a helper to work at eye level with dogs, instead of towering over them in a dominating manner. You will learn how to teach correct barking and to control and shape grips, to help handlers develop full control over their dog's aggression. Imagine teaching a dog explosive barking in full aggression, and then giving them the tools to control themselves and turn off like a light switch. You will leave this workshop with the ability to teach these skills and much more.

Handlers, does your dog lack power, intensity or realism, or is he the type that is so driven, that he lacks all self control? Is your dog in conflict in the protection phase? Is he difficult to "OUT"? Does he look between you and the helper instead of focusing on the "bad guy"? Do you lose obedience control in the protection phase? Do you wish that your dog had more confidence? If you answer, "Yes", to any of these questions, this workshop is for you. This program gives your dog the skills to become a super sport dog, police dog, or family guardian.



About Gene England

Gene has been involved in dog training for over 38 years. He still trains dogs for police departments from all over the USA in Scottsville, KY. Although retired from competition, he is still involved in the sport of Schutzhund, working with dog, handler teams in tracking, as well as, the protection phase.

Gene won the 1982 North American Championship, the 1983 Schutzhund III Tournament, the 1984 & 1991 FH Championship, as well as the 1990 World Qualifier. One of the highlights in his competition was finishing first place in the 1992 International World Championship in Tengen, West Germany. He also represented USA on World Teams. In addition, Gene has worked with many of the top dog/handler teams in the country.

Gene is recognized as an expert in tracking. His innovations and techniques in this phase are currently used worldwide by many of the top teams today.

In keeping with his philosophy of teaching, Gene has agreed to do a series of table training seminars to teach training helpers and handlers, the use of the tables to benefit their training programs.
